**To create your Wildflower Patio container here are our top tips:**

- **Choose our Patio Collection** or select your own wildflowers from our shop.
- **Peat free compost** is ideal for planting your container; look for a compost that's not too high in nitrogen but with some nutrients to feed the plants through the season.
- **If choosing your own wildflowers**, select different heights to plant, with low growing wildflowers at the edge and taller ones in the middle or towards the back.
- **Repeat** the chosen wildflowers, if planting several containers. This will allow pollinators to move between the containers.
- **Water your container** when first planted. The container will also need water daily if the weather is warm.
